## FORENSIC SCIENCE DOCUMENTARIES

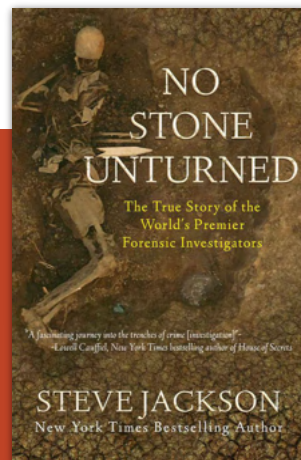
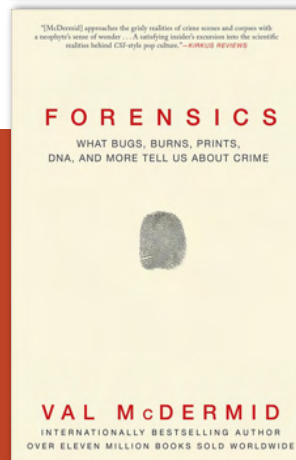
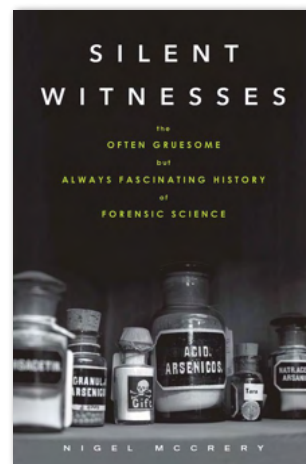
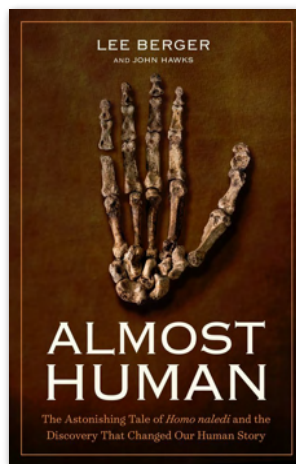
